Background

Position Summary:

Camp Rodef Shalom is seeking an energetic, enthusiastic, detail oriented, and organized photographer to join our summer season! The photographer is responsible for taking photographs and videos of campers throughout the camp day. They may be on-site or off-site depending on the day and schedule. A camera is provided but you are also welcome to use your own camera if you are more comfortable with that. The photographer is also responsible for uploading all pictures at the end of the week to the camp website and editing photos and videos. The photographer works closely with the assistant camp director to ensure that all age groups and activities are represented in the photos and that all photos are uploaded in a timely manner.

Qualifications:

- Must be 16 before 9/30/2024
- Complete Staff Training and available to work the entire camp session and bonus weeks
- Experience, expertise in and passion for photography and knowledge of how to edit and upload photos is required
- Experience working with children is preferred
- Must be self-motivated and able to work as a team player and to problem solve
- Knowledge of Microsoft applications and Wix is a plus
- Must be able to participate in physical activity for the duration of the camp day: be on feet for most of the day, be outside in heat and sun, etc.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Take photos and videos of campers and staff throughout the day so that all age groups and activities are represented.
- Exhibiting role model behavior for co-workers and campers
- Collaborate with bunk counselors and specialists to ensure pictures are clear and come out exciting
- Report any concerns or incidents to Leadership Team
- Attend all camp wide programming, field trips, and be on call via walkie
- Edit all photos and videos to ensure the best photos are uploaded
- Upload all photos and videos to the camp website at the end of each week
